IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Event conducted under the 2003 SCCA Solo II rules and CFR/SCCA Solo II Supplemental Regulations.
- All regular 2003 SCCA Solo II Open and Ladies classes plus regional Expert, and Novice classes are available. Karts are now approved for this site.
- Event is open to all licensed drivers.
- Event trophies will be distributed at the close of the event on Sunday.
- **SNELL 90** (or later) approved helmets are required; loaners are available. **DOT-only helmets are NOT acceptable.**
- Seat belts are required in all cars originally equipped with them. Vehicles must pass a basic safety inspection (battery securely mounted, no loose articles in car, tire tread acceptable and so on).
- Mufflers are required on all cars. Sound limit is 98db.
- All entrants are required to work course assignments. Some work positions are available before and/or after the event. Contact the Event Chairman for details.
- Special instruction activities (ride and drive) available for novice entrants. Instructed Novice walk-through will be at 9:15am.
- **IMPORTANT RULE: No Nitrous Oxide Bottles allowed anywhere on site!**
