EVENT SITE:

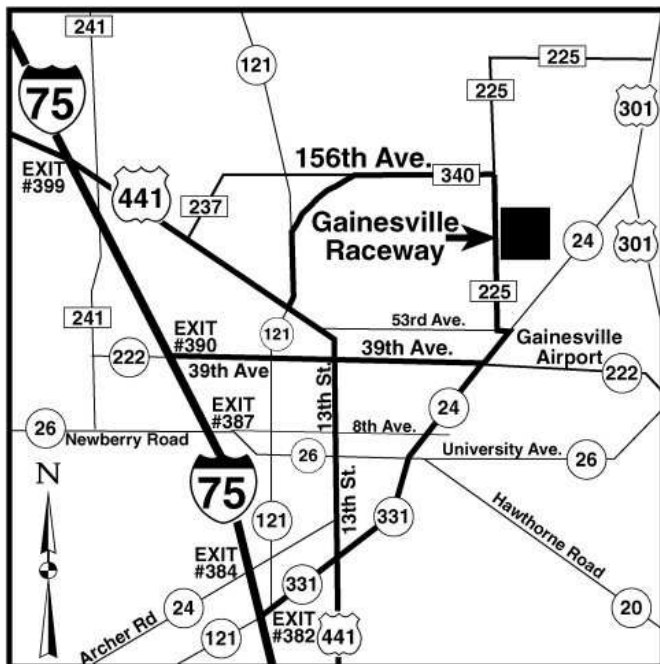
**GAINESVILLE INTERNATIONAL RACEWAY–
GAINESVILLE, FL**

Traveling S. on I-75 take exit #399 and turn left onto US 441 S. Go about 12 miles and turn left on CR 121. In about 3 miles turn right onto 156th Ave (CR 340). In 3.8 miles take right fork onto CR 225, travel about 2.7 miles to racetrack.

Traveling N. on I-75, take exit #382, Williston RD (CR 331), turn left (East) to Waldo RD (SR 24) and go N. Turn left on NE 53rd Ave and make the immediate right onto CR 225, go 3.5 miles to track.

Or, take exit #390, 39th Ave (CR 222) turn right heading East, to Waldo RD (SR 24), turn left. Turn left onto NE 53rd Ave and make the immediate right onto CR 225, go 3.5 miles to track.

After entering the site, follow the paved “road” straight back, do not turn left towards the grand stands and drag strip.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

NEW FOR 2005 –

- 1) Shoe polish will no longer be allowed. Blue tape may be used and will be available for \$5 per roll. There will be no more free tape. Numbers must be on the car before you go to tech! Numbers should be a minimum of 8” high and 1 ¼” stroke.
 - 2) Annual tech will be available to any SCCA member. You can get your car and helmet teched for the 2005 year. You must have permanent magnetic or vinyl numbers.
- Event conducted under the 2005 SCCA Solo II rules and CFR/SCCA Solo II Supplemental Regulations.
 - All regular 2005 SCCA Solo II Open and Ladies classes plus Expert and Novice classes are available. Karts are approved for this site.
 - Event is open to all licensed drivers.
 - Event trophies will be distributed at the close of the event on Sunday.
 - SNELL 90 (or later) approved helmets are required; loaners are available. DOT-only helmets are NOT acceptable.
 - Seat belts are required in all cars originally equipped with them. Vehicles must pass a basic safety inspection

(battery securely mounted, no loose articles in car, tire tread acceptable and so on).

- Mufflers are required on all cars. Sound limit is 98db.
- All entrants are required to work course assignments. Some work positions are available before and/or after the event. Contact the Event Chairman for details.
- Special instruction activities (ride and drive) available for novice entrants. Instructed Novice walk-through will be at 9:15am.
- **IMPORTANT RULE: No Nitrous Oxide Bottles allowed anywhere on site!**
